Minutes of Regular Meeting: January 13, 2022

I. Time and Date:

Meeting brought to order at 6:35 PM. Meeting adjourned at 8:11 PM. Next meeting March 10, 2022 at 6:30 PM via Zoom.

II. Treasurers Report:

There has been no activity for the month. The account balance remains the same. The previous treasurer's family member will be in town soon, and has been apprised of the need to return bank statements and several checks left in the previous treasurer's possession. Margy will arrange for the previous treasurer to be removed from signature card and Katie Fisher to be added.

III. Councilman Kashmann:

- a) DU Master Framework Plan is undergoing a refresh. Mr. Kashmann is on the committee. They have had 2 introductory meetings. It was mentioned that a neighbor liaison was supposed to be on the committee, but that UNNA was not informed as to who this might be, or how they would be chosen.
- b) Redrawing Council district boundaries meetings are upcoming. Denvergo.org/redistricting has details regarding these meeting times and places.
- c) 308 Rescue Act Plan information may be found on denvergov.org under ARPA funding
- d) The proposed dog park at Veteran's Park is undergoing public hearings. Some will be remote as well. Tinyurl.com/veteransdogpark
- e) Mr. Kashmann attended the YMCA property development meeting. He reports that the latest meeting relayed information that was in the early stages, mostly pictures and generalities. More information may be found at DenverYMCA.org/university-hills-redevelopment.
- f) A lively discussion regarding bike lanes and city development occurred. There were several different points of view. The final consensus was that this may be a topic of interest for future meetings with factual input from the City of Denver regarding what is planned, what the costs might be and where funds would come from.
